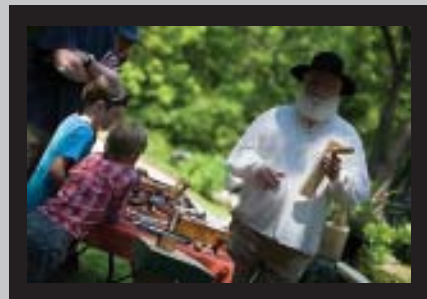

# Haverford Reserve Update

Work on Community Park progressed during the winter; below is a brief summary.

## Recreation/Environmental Building

In April, 6 architectural firms were chosen to submit proposals for the Recreation/Environmental Building. At this time plans include a double gym, fitness/wellness area, environmental nature area, elevated walking track and community meeting rooms. Construction of the facility is expected to begin in late 2009 or 2010.

## Outdoor Facilities- Active Area

The ballfields, lights and parking areas are nearly complete. The walking paths, bathrooms and pavilions are expected to be in by September. Two of the fields will be available this fall. The splash park and dog park are planned for the spring of 2010.

## Trails and Open Space

The South Brook Trail is open for walking. The North Brook lower loop is 2/3 complete. The Darby Creek Trail and the Meadows Trail are awaiting approval by the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.

The Freedom Playground Committee is holding the fundraisers below to help raise funds for the community built inclusive playground planned for Community Park.

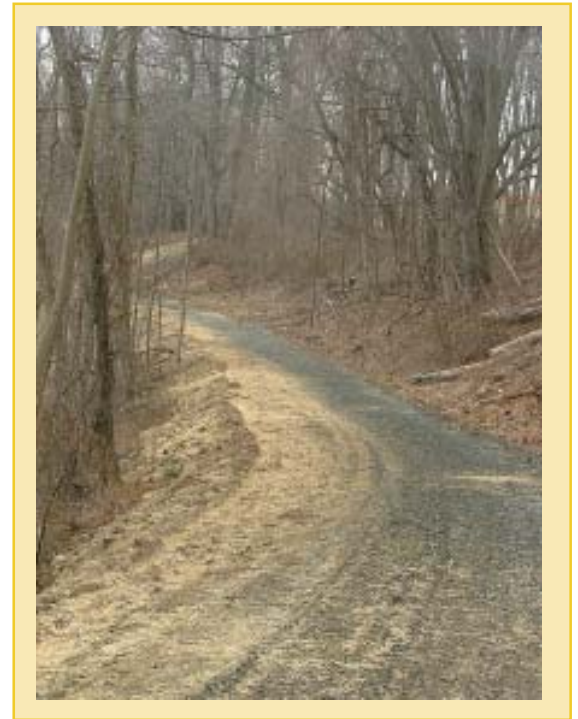

## Summer Energy Saving Tips

Summer is almost here and everything's looking up: temperatures, fuel prices and electrical bills are all climbing. What can you do about it?

*Try these tips to save money and help the planet keep its cool.*

### Replace incandescent bulbs with compact fluorescent lights

Compact fluorescent light bulbs use only a third as much electricity as a standard bulb. Because a compact fluorescent will usually last ten times longer than a regular bulb, it will easily pay for itself. If every household in the U.S. replaced one light bulb with a compact fluorescent, it would prevent enough pollution to equal the removal of one million cars from the road.

### Defrost your Freezer

The frost and ice that builds up in your freezer over time does more than make it hard to get your ice cream- it also causes your freezer to work harder to keep the freezer at a cold temperature. By routinely defrosting your freezer, you can keep your ice cream cold and the planet cool.

### Video games and plugs

Unplug video games when not in use. They use up a lot of energy even when they are turned off.

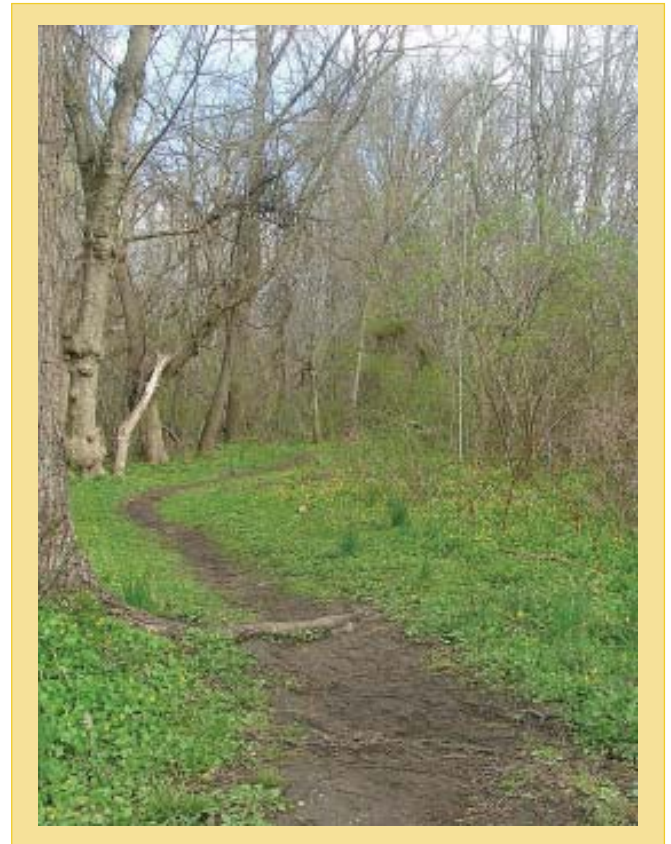

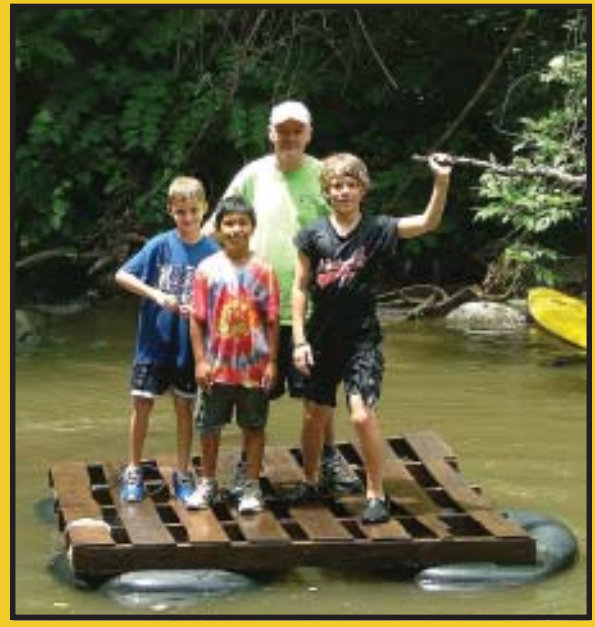

## Park Maintenance Change

Beginning in January 2009, Park Maintenance is a division of the Parks and Recreation Department. Recognizing the value and benefits of our parks to our residents, the township has assigned a crew dedicated to the year round maintenance of our 33 parks and recreation facilities. Our goal is to maximize the resources available to us to develop short and long term plans to keep our parks safe and clean for your enjoyment. A recent study by the University of Pennsylvania Wharton School showed that home values increase an average of 13% within 1 mile of a well-maintained park. Every home in Haverford Township is within one mile of a park. Parks are an investment in our township's economic, physical and social well being. ## Park Improvements Policy

We are fortunate to have so many individuals and organizations in our township interested in doing work to change or improve their local parks. Often the improvements are directly related to their groups use of the facility. Although the efforts are well-intentioned they can sometimes cause long term maintenance issues or interfere with other user groups at that park. We are working with the Park Board to develop guidelines regarding any improvements or changes to township facilities done by individuals or civic organizations.

Did you know that one hour of use by a lawn mower produces the carbon equal to eleven cars? A riding mower equals thirty four cars. As part of our effort to create a more green-friendly township we are looking for ways to make more sustainable parks.
